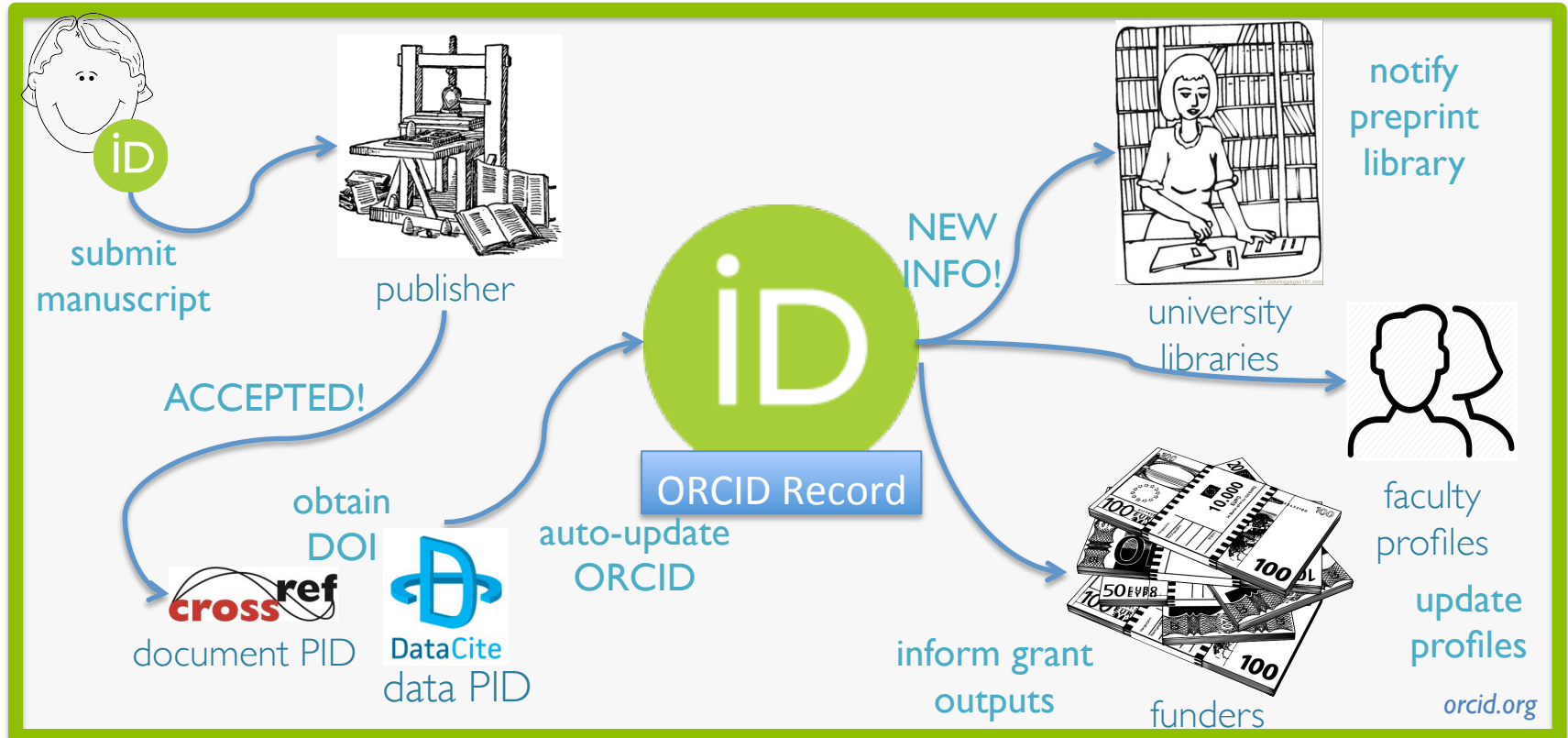

- Institution SSO for ORCID iD use/connections

- Incorporation of ORCID iDs into Federated Identity schemas
 - Provisioned attribute for person ID in eduPerson schema (MACE-Dir WG)

 - SAML <-> ORCID linking service (SURFnet) – Exposes ORCID iD attribute via the SAML query protocol (<http://bit.ly/1KNIhUH>)
